

# QuickStart

## Installation Guide

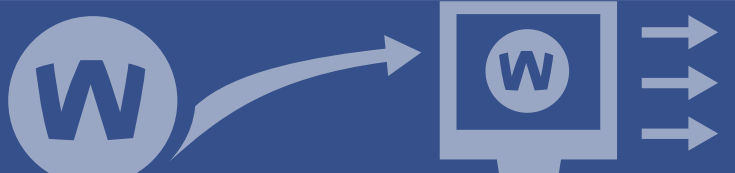


Before you install WinSuite on your NT/2000/2003 Network, the network must already be installed and operating correctly. If you are having network issues, you should clear those before you attempt to install any client-server based software such as WinSuite.

- WinSuite can be installed on Windows NT Server 4.0, Server 2000, and Server 2003 as well as all 9x, ME, 2000 Pro, and XP Pro client machines.
- Your client computers must be members of the domain.
- Your users must be logging into the domain (not the local machine). This can be either using individual user accounts or using one or more generic accounts (i.e. **"student"**)
- Your users must be members of a Global Security Group (other than Domain Users). If your users do not belong to a group, you should create a group now and make the users that you want to secure a member of that group. Security settings are applied by groups, so if you wanted teachers and two sets of students to have different security settings, you would need to create a separate group for each. (i.e. **"Teacher Group"**, **"Student1 Group"**, and **"Student2 Group"**)



## 1 Check system/ network requirements



WinSuite must be installed on your Primary Domain Controller (on NT Domains) or PDC Emulator (on 2000/2003 Domains) and will use less than 20 megabytes of space on your server's System Drive/Partition.

- To begin the WinSuite installation, click on the **"Install WinSuite"** button on the Welcome Screen.
- It is recommended that you accept all of the default settings (except the Users Directory) for installing WinSuite onto your server's System Drive/Partition and creating the necessary shares.
- You will want to have WinSuite create your Users Directory/Share on the largest volume on your server. This directory is where any of your new user home directories will be created.

## 2 Install WinSuite on your server



- On the server, open the WinSuite Administrator from the Start Menu.
- The **"WinSuite Licensing & Registration Wizard"** will appear.
- Select either **"License"** if you have already purchased and received your License File OR select **"Continue Evaluation"** if you would like to evaluate WinSuite on up to 5 client computers for a period of 30 days.
- If you selected **"License,"** you will then need to select **"Browse for License File"** to find and apply the license file that you were shipped. Once the license file has been applied, the WinSuite Administrator will open and you may continue.
- If you selected **"Continue Evaluation,"** the WinSuite Administrator will open and you may continue.

## 3 License WinSuite

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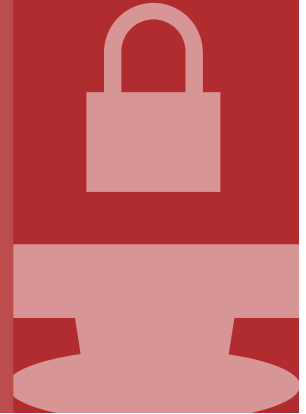


Once the WinSuite Administrator is open, try changing just a few security settings. These are a few of the most common options:

- This first screen of the WinSuite Administrator lists the "**Available Groups**" in the left-hand column. Tick the box beside the group that you want to change the settings for (i.e. "**Student Group**")
- After you have ticked the group, select the "**Logon Style**" tab and then in the "**When Logging On:**" box, select "**Type their Username.**"
- Next, go to the "**Logon Settings**" menu on the top menu bar and select the following two settings: "Use Standard Font" AND "**Logon User First, then Group.**"
- Now, select the "**Desktop**" tab. From the center "**Start Menu Items**" column, un-tick "**Favorites**", "**Documents**", "**Settings**", "**Find/Search**" and "**Run.**" From the "**Miscellaneous**" box in the lower-right column, un-tick "**Personalized Menus**" and "**Right-Click in Explorer/Desktop.**"

Now you have set some security settings that you should be able to notice just as soon as you install the WinSuite Client onto your client computer.

## 4 Apply a few security settings



The WinSuite Client can be installed either manually (as explained here) or through a logon script. (as explained in the Getting Started Manual)

- Logon to the client computer as a member of the "**Domain Admins**" group.
- From the "Start Menu," select "Run" and type the following path into the dialog box:  
`\\YOURSERVERNAME\ROLLNT$`
- Make sure that YOURSERVERNAME represents the name of the server that you installed WinSuite on.
- Click OK to automatically browse to this path.
- Double-click on the "**Setup.exe**" icon.
- Once the installation starts, click "**Continue**" and then "**OK.**"

When the installation finishes, the computer will reboot.

After the computer reboots, you will see the new logon screen. You can logon to the domain as you would normally.

## 5 Install the WinSuite Client onto a client computer



Since you have already set some security settings, you should be able to logon and see the settings in action.

- Logon to the machine as a user who is a member of the group that you applied security settings to in Step Four. When you click on the Start Menu you should see that the menu is noticeably shorter and does not contain the items that you restricted in Step Four.
- To make changes to these security settings, you can logon as a member of the Domain Admins group and then either Select "**WinSuite Administrator**" from the popup box, or browse your network to  
`\\YOURSERVERNAME\WSADMIN$`  
and then run the AdminWS.exe program to launch the WinSuite Administrator.



## 6 Check and change your settings
